Research on the Application of Lacquer Painting Techniques in Modern Handicrafts

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Abstract: Lacquer painting as a traditional craft art form, its cultural connotation and artistic value can effectively improve the market demand for modern handicrafts. In order to promote the integration of lacquer painting and modern decoration, the application of lacquer painting techniques in modern handicrafts is proposed. Firstly, the concept of lacquer painting is analyzed, and the artistic language of lacquer painting is explored in the light of the specific classification of the craft. From the perspective of human-oriented and inheritance, the application principle of lacquer painting is analyzed, and it is proposed that the traditional aesthetics of lacquer art should be combined with modern design aesthetics. Finally, it is proposed that lacquer painting can be applied in three aspects, namely, thematic application, symbolic application and embellishment application, so as to integrate traditional lacquer painting techniques with modern handicrafts design and inject new vitality into the modern handicrafts market.

2. Conceptual analysis

2.1 Concept of Lacquer Painting

Lacquer painting refers to a traditional process of painting and decorating works of art, mainly using lacquer^[5]. The word "painting" refers to the process of lacquering objects with lacquer, while the word "decorating" implies the meaning of ornamentation and decoration. This craft not only focuses on the selection and use of lacquer, but also involves many aspects such as pattern design, color matching, and carving techniques, thus creating colorful and unique artistic effects. Lacquer painting mainly uses natural lacquer, which has unique physical and chemical properties, such as high strength after drying, corrosion resistance and abrasion resistance. At the same time, lacquer can also be used in combination with a variety of materials, such as wood, metal, ceramics, etc., to create more colorful artistic effects^[6].

2.2 Artistic Language of Lacquerware Painting Technique

There are mainly 8 kinds of ancient lacquer ware painting techniques, also known as "eight methods of painting", i.e., painting, painting, inlaying, carving and filling, grinding and drawing, stacking, honoring painting, and carving lacquer eight techniques. For example, the word "painting" means to put lacquer on an object. The method of painting is the most basic technique in lacquer art, and many other techniques are developed on this basis. The painting process can be divided into two types: plain painting and colored painting. The main technique of plain lacquering is monochrome lacquering, which is more often used indoors. Painting is in the processing of good artifacts for the depiction of patterns and designs, do not have to cover the dye, push the light and other processes, this method to make the furniture more gorgeous. There are also stacked molding process, stacked molding process refers to the smooth lacquer surface, with viscous thick lacquer plus charcoal powder, lacquer ash and other materials for the pile up, and then in the high up on the pattern and then decorated. Pile molding techniques vary; from the form can be divided into: line pile, surface pile, thin pile (shallow relief), high pile (high relief). In the realm of interior space design, the walls can be transformed into captivating features through intricate pile molding processes. This technique not only enhances the wall design with relief patterns, but also significantly amplifies the sense of three-dimensionality and atmosphere within the space[7]. Historically, ancient lacquerwork predominantly featured black and red hues, with artisans striving to achieve vibrant and multicolored effects. To accomplish this, they harnessed the unique viscosity of lacquer, utilizing it as a medium to adhere decorative elements of natural materials.

This led to the development of intricate craftsmanship such as tin inlay, eggshell inlay, bone and stone inlay, among others. These techniques involved meticulously cutting and shaping various materials, including precious metals, organic substances like eggshells, and natural stones, before inlaying them into the lacquered surface. The resulting walls became works of art, telling stories through their intricate patterns and vibrant colors, adding depth and character to the interior spaces.

The patterns of lacquering craft and its performance themes are rich and varied, and its main performance themes include geometric patterns, auspicious imagery, narrative scenes, etc^[8]. Geometric patterns are the most important elements of lacquering patterns. Geometric pattern is the most widely used pattern form in the painting pattern, most of the geometric pattern forms are relatively neat, and its painting effect has a sense of order and rhythmic beauty. Auspicious imagery themes include animal and plant motifs, plant motifs not only depict the natural beauty of the landscape, but also auspicious and beautiful symbolism. Animal tattoos and natural animal tattoos, animal tattoos commonly used in dragon, phoenix, taotie, unicorn and other subjects, most of these tattoos are used to express some kind of emotion. Natural animal tattoos have various forms, abstract and figurative forms, among which the common tattoos are tiger, fish, birds and other tattoos with good symbolic meanings. Narrative scene motifs are the fusion of the previous motifs, presenting the atmosphere of the scene in its entirety, and the use of patterns to shape the story of the picture and the sense of spatial atmosphere^[9].

3. Lacquer painting techniques in modern crafts design application principles

3.1 People-centered principle

The principle of human-centered design emphasizes innovation on the basis of respect for tradition. In the modern application of lacquerware painting techniques, it is necessary to firstly inherit its exquisite skills and profound cultural heritage, and at the same time innovate with modern aesthetics and market demand. 4. Application Strategies of Lacquer Painting Techniques in Modern Crafts

4.1 Thematic application forms

Interior theme space design, on the one hand, is to meet the social and cultural development, art and aesthetic culture of diversification, on the other hand, is to make space and art, space and people, art and life more closely. Therefore, space theme decoration must have connotation, that is, artistic spirit and artistic connotation. The traditional cultural heritage of lacquerware painting and decorating techniques and its unique artistic style as well as the cultural symbols embedded in the patterns and motifs are suitable for spreading the culture of intangible cultural heritage and creating the theme of national consciousness of the spatial atmosphere^[14]. The main design performance are: first, the use of lacquer painting patterns to express the space theme, the extraction of lacquer painting technology in auspicious imagery theme patterns used in space design, meaning good luck, the choice of decorative patterns in the space should be combined with the type of space, more in line with the needs of the service object, the most important thing is that it should be combined with the overall spatial atmosphere. For example, in the application of lodging space in recent years, the original pattern should be deconstructed, restructured, and modernized so that the traditional pattern and modern design principles are integrated to present a visual effect more in line with contemporary aesthetic concepts, thus creating a modern and traditional lacquer cultural flavor of the theme of space. The second is to use color to express the theme of space, coordinate the color used in the space with the lacquer art, and create a lacquer art cultural theme space through the change of color. For example, in the design of display space, the black and red colors commonly used in lacquer art can be extracted and decorated to create the artistic effect of lacquer art space, so that people can understand the culture of lacquer art more intuitively and experience the cultural atmosphere of lacquer art. Third, the use of lighting to assist the design of the performance theme, indoor space lighting is indispensable, different lights can create a different spatial atmosphere. Therefore, we can use light mapping to strengthen the cultural characteristics of lacquer art and national spirit^[15].






Figure 1: Lacquer Art Museum Furnishings

For example, a designer designed a lacquer art gallery using a thematic application. The entrance of this design scheme utilizes a thematic design approach, with forest-themed decorative wall panels at the entrance, creating a thematic atmosphere as a transition between the city and nature, and introducing customers to the quiet and elegant lacquer atmosphere. Lacquer Museum is the office and display function as one of the space types, the space color extracted from the lacquer in the black and red colors, so the space color tone for the dark tone, green, red, blue decorative paintings is the focus of the space, and to change the lighting, together to create the lacquer themed atmosphere, specific as shown in Figure 1.

When incorporating lacquer elements into a space, one can draw inspiration from the rich tapestry of traditional Chinese patterns and decorations. These include exquisite lacquer trousseaus, intricately carved lacquer plates, the timeless motifs found in portrait stones, and the vivid hues and intricate narratives of Dunhuang murals. By incorporating such cultural treasures, the space is imbued with a sense of history, elegance, and deep cultural significance. By tapping the resources from traditional arts and inheriting the cultural lineage, we discover and recreate the symbols and elements that inherit the traditional Chinese culture. Using this technique, these symbols and elements are integrated and repeated in the interior space to emphasize the cultural theme atmosphere of lacquer in the space. There is also the application of formal symbols, formal symbols are generally divided into direct and indirect application, for some symbols with significant lacquer cultural characteristics can be directly applied in the space, while the indirect application needs to be combined with modern aesthetics to innovate, presenting the lacquer culture in the space in a metaphorical form, to meet the indoor space decoration and inheritance of lacquer culture at the same time
