(2) emotional experience. Without this understanding, it is difficult to express the original feelings and ideas of the work by simply imitating the stage performance. Therefore, a stage performer in learning stage performance, need to dabble in the knowledge of various disciplines, improve their overall cultivation, in the work has a rich emotional experience, can express the emotion of the work and form their own style of performance[15].

4. An Effective Approach to the Expression of Emotion in Performance Teaching

4.1. A thorough interpretation of stage works

The creation of stage works not only comes from life, but also reflects the author's creative thinking. Therefore, the stage actor should master the emotional expression of the stage performance after the interpretation of the role, so as to present a vivid "begonia" for people.

4.2. Careful capture of the image of the stage

The emotion of the stage character is usually manifested by the physical action of the stage actor and gives people a certain stage image. Especially in the process of emotional transmission, the audience will bring a strong image impact. Therefore, the actors should capture the characters carefully so as to show them vividly. Then, through in-depth understanding and intensive training to improve the body movements of actors' proficiency. It should be noted that the characters of stage works are derived from life and deeper than life. They have obvious character characteristics and can be displayed through specific body movements. For example, if you want to show the role of an elderly person, you can do it by bending or bending down, stumbling and so on, and the hero character is usually an imposing, vigorous figure. The actor can be reflected by raising his head and raising his chest, etc. Therefore, performers should pay attention to the capture of stage images in order to achieve the overall expression of the characters. Stage actors should understand the child's character and routine during the performance. For example, bouncing around, a smile and so on, to show the child's enthusiasm and innocence. If the audience can not realize that this is the image of a child in the viewing process, then the stage work should be a failure, and the stage actor's grasp of the character image is not in place, thus bringing the audience a deviation in understanding. Therefore, stage actors should capture the stage image carefully in the process of life and training, so as to highlight the image characteristics of the characters, so as to facilitate the audience to distinguish the characters and realize the understanding of the stage works.

4.3. Fully explore the stage works in the music color

Although emotion is the soul of the stage, it can be strengthened by the color of music. For example, when performing a tragic role, the stage actors can play sad music to strengthen the emotional transmission of the audience, thus helping the audience to accurately understand the location of the stage role. This is mainly because music can create a kind of artistic conception for the performer, and then lay the emotional expression of the work. Also, actors need to be emotional before the performance, and the musical rendering allows the actor's emotions to come in faster and present the best performance. For example, in the stage work "Spring River Flower Moon Night", the rhythm of music is relatively clear, gradually changing

from slow to fast rhythm, thus creating a beautiful, profound artistic conception, and then constructing a beautiful "Flower Moon Night." The performers then show the serenity and beauty of the night by performing props and looking around. With the ups and downs of music, the stage gradually to the climax, thus to the audience on the visual and auditory impact. In this process, the development of the concert stage works plays a great role, and provides a good condition for the stage actors' emotion to be brought into and rendered. Therefore, actors should fully express the musical color of stage works and attach importance to the role of music on the stage.

5. Conclusions

As the soul of stage, emotion plays a very important role in promoting stage art. Therefore, the stage actors should pay full attention to the expression of emotional expression in the stage performance, deeply interpret the stage works, capture the stage image in detail, and make full use of the emotional rendering function of music.
