4.5 The Problems That Should Be Paid Attention to in the Application of Opal Art in Fashion Design

1) In the clothing design, the visual focus formed by the arrangement and combination of geometric elements and the decorative parts of the clothing can be used to design the clothing. The change points of OPP art appear in cuff, low waistline and other places, which can play the role of decoration and beautification of clothing. 2) Using the visual illusion produced by the OPP pattern, combining the human body curve and the structural line of the clothing, the structure of the clothing can be more clear and prominent, so as to achieve the purpose of decoration and sculpture. For example, in the chest and buttocks of clothing, the stripes will be widened, the lattice will be enlarged, and the color will be lightened, while in the waist, the stripes will be dense, the lattice will be reduced, and the color will be deepened, so that people will have the visual effect of breast, buttock and willow waist after dressing, and successfully shape the breast and buttock lines of women's plump, as well as the slim waist. 3) Improper application of opal art will make clothing style obscure and structure unclear. In order to avoid dazzling people, we can combine the OPP pattern with the plain color fabric, use the OPP pattern in large areas such as the body and skirt, and use the plain color fabric for splicing or edging in the collar, cuffs, placket and other parts of the clothing, so as to make the clothing design proper contrast between the real and the virtual, clear overall priority and secondary, clear clothing style at a glance, and complete effect. 4) Due to the rich levels and strong three-dimensional effect of OPP's patterns, we should first determine the key points of the design when designing clothing. If we want to highlight the patterns of OPP's art, we should strive to be concise and reduce the segmentation, make the patterns as complete as possible, and make people's attention fully focus on the unique visual charm brought by the OPP's patterns[8].

Through the above analysis, it can be found that the artistic style itself has a great ABSTRAC Tion, because it has a strong performance ability and dizzy visual effect has been more and more people's attention and love. Applying this artistic style to the process of clothing design can make clothing more three-dimensional and expressive.
