Chinese children's youth movies emphasize featuring the image of girls as goddesses. In summary, Children's movies in China still do not break through the astriction of traditional ideas in shaping the image of girls, and always associate them with such labels as weakness, motherhood and fate.

2. Uniqueness of Girls' Image under the Child Standard

Chinese children's movies based on the standard of children can uniquely characterize the image of girls, making them naive, lovely and direct in personality. Active, naive, and dare to tell the truth is the characteristics of girls and boys in Chinese children's movies, such as the movie *Duo duo*. The image of sensible playmates is also more common in Chinese children's movies, which mainly focus attention on the campus. In this way, girls'

image as playmates will be more prominent. They are more mature and sensible than boys of the same age. However, it is due to the influence of gender roles on children's growth. Children have a very strong ability to imitate, so the behavior of adults or even the people around them in life will have an impact on them. In addition, parents and teachers continuously strengthen the girls' behavior to accord with their gender characteristics, and finally let the label of sensible and obedient attached to the girl.

3. Differences between Animated and Non-Animated Movies
