Research on the Cultivation and Evaluation of Archival Professionals Based on Outcome-Based Education (OBE) Concept

3. The rationality of using the OBE concept to guide the training and evaluation of archival science professionals

4.4 Plan the relevant content of social practice

The OBE concept advocates thinking about problems through reverse thinking, which means that colleges and universities can analyze the relevant requirements of the archival industry for talents and arrange students to participate in some corresponding social practice activities. Colleges and universities can establish social practice bases as needed to provide practical opportunities for archival students. While carrying out practical activities, universities should strengthen cooperation with relevant enterprises outside the university, so as to provide more internship positions for students to increase their practical experience. In the early stage of students' enrollment, colleges and universities can hold relevant activities related to archival work knowledge in schools to increase students' understanding of archival-related work.

4.5 Establish a talent evaluation system

The talent training model formed on the basis of the OBE concept needs to configure the corresponding talent evaluation mechanism, so that it can cultivate professional talents that truly meet the needs of the archives industry. First of all, in all aspects of teaching should set up corresponding evaluation standards, in order to grasp the overall situation of students at various stages, while the evaluation of students' final results is also the top priority, so that it can determine whether the goal of talent training has been achieved, in the establishment of talent evaluation system, but also to determine the graduation threshold, the student's professional level to meet the requirements to graduate.
