What Is A Good Teacher For High School Students? -- A survey of high schools in Yangtze River Delta

Abstract: through the methods of literature review, questionnaire survey and mathematical statistics, this paper makes a survey and research on senior high school students in the Yangtze River Delta region, and gets the following conclusions: (1) students generally pay more attention to teachers' teaching methods and basic qualities (such as professional knowledge, ability of communicating with others, etc.) than their appearance; (2) boys' and girls' evaluation of good teachers has significant differences in personal image indicators; (3) The significant differences are mainly focused on the following indicators: images, hobbies, language expressions and teaching styles.

1. Introduction

Senior high school students are in the critical period of enriching themselves and self-developing, so the image of teachers' ethics will have a great influence on them. A good teacher should not only has great attainments in the teaching field, but also should be outstanding in other abilities, such as the ways of efficient learning or research methods, reasonable time planning ability or positive attitude to face difficulties and challenges. Therefore, by getting along and studying with these professors, students can gain valuable life experience and qualities, which is very helpful for their later academic and career development. Therefore, we explore the "what is a good teacher for high school students?' The purpose of this project is to help students judge and choose good teachers, and also improve the level of teachers themselves by following the standard.

2. Literature Review

Wang Wenhui (2020) used the survey to investigate the ideal image of teachers among the primary school students. The result shows that senior students expect teachers to be humorous and interesting, and also not use corporal punishments.

Zhao Yifeng (2015) used the literature review, questionnaire survey and mathematical statistics to investigate the junior middle school students in Xiacheng District of Hangzhou. The results showed that the students paid more attention to the teachers' teaching methods, personalities, images and the ways of treating students.

3. Research Design

3.1 research issues

For the modern students' evaluation of teachers, it is concluded that students generally pay attention to the external image, internal quality and teaching methods of teachers. Therefore, the following targeted questions are issued in the investigation and research:

a) What is the image of a good teacher in high school education?

- c) Can a good teacher make the students easy and relax during the classtime?

3.2 Research methods

Questionnaire survey method: 100 questionnaires for total and 86 were recovered, with a recovery rate of 86%. The major indicators of the questionnaire are teacher's personal image, including personality, temper, knowledge and qualification and also the teacher's teaching standard, including class form, teaching style, education method treatment of students, evaluation and management.

Secondly, it can help forming a positive and interactive classroom atmosphere which could increase the attention of the kids. Students care about the language communication just as the statistic shows that about 40% of students want their teachers have a good communicating skill, since sometimes they could not understand each and everything, so the guidance of teacher is quite essential. This also can form an excellent interaction between teachers and the students.

Thirdly, it can shorten the distance between teachers and students to make them work more tightly. Over 50% of students prefer their teachers to wear the casual clothes and have a tender tongue of speaking, being as their close friends or their nice parents. In addition to being more easy to get along with each otherThis kind of intimacy can not only help students learn knowledge but also learn how to ease the pressure of learning.

Unwilling to know, lazy in management are both the very serious of issues that caused the students don't want to accept new things and even the teachers.

For this study, the data show that students prefer teachers who are good teachers and helpful friends which the number is up to 68.6%, but they don't like teachers who are strict. In particular, some teachers like to use comparison to criticize or praise. When the students do not do well, find an excellent student to compare. When students do well, they find a very poor student to set off, like 'you are much better than that student'. However, students are not willing to accept any criticise or encouragement in this way, about 70% of the high scholl students want their teachers to talk about their performance face to face privately. Teachers should learn to appreciate each student, to see their differences, and their own specialties.

Not only that, the teachers who will pay attention to students' personal life will be more welcome, which has 54.65% of students approved. They think that they can be closer to their life, and understand them better, so they have a stronger sense of identity and are more willing to listen to them in class.

5. Conclusion and Discussion

To a certain extent, the teaching style and the attitude towards students determine whether they can become good teachers or not. Therefore, it is suggested that high school teachers, on the premise of completing their own teaching tasks, often think about their own teaching methods, and find teaching styles which is suitable for themselves and students. Specifically, they should be humorous and interesting, treat students like friends, less punishments but more encouragements and adjust the homework and pay attention on the students' completion to avoid too much pressure, and feel energetic to study.

It is the so-called 'strict teacher, good apprentice', just as the saying goes 'the best way to learn is to

learn from the best', which must be the decisive factor for students to maintain good academic performance, but not all children are suitable for this kind of education. We must respect students' self-esteem, be patient and careful with children, and be good at persuasion, so as to establish a better image and prestige among students, then the teacher would be much easier for students to accept.

When faced with introverted students who are very sensitive with their performance at school, teachers need solid academic knowledge. A teacher who is not enough academically can not satisfy the students' thirst for knowledge. This will not only hinder the process of communication and learning with students, but also affect teachers' own career development.

For naughty students, teachers need to have strong pressure resistance ability for controlling the classroom since it is very easily to lose control when a group of young teenagers gather together. This is a very important lesson that teachers need to learn in their professionalism. Knowing how to control the classroom (especially the large classroom with 50 + students in China) and guidance will have a great impact on the relationship between teachers and students, as well as guiding learning enthusiasm. By the way, this ability has a lot to do with the teacher's character and quality.

For special students, teachers need to have long-term observation, patience and sense of responsibility. The age range during high school is the golden period of time for the personality development, so finding and solving problems is the indispensable quality of teachers to help high school students.
